EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES

1. All exhibit booths must be manned at all times during viewing hours.
2. No sales are permitted at the exhibit booths.
3. Aisles must be kept clear and no banners, signs, etc. will be allowed which interfere with views of adjacent or nearby booths.
4. No subletting of space will be permitted.
5. Only exhibiting companies may distribute literature or samples.
6. Exhibitors who make booth reservations by September 1, 2010 will be listed in the official program given to all attendees. No refunds for cancellations after September 10.
7. It is expressly understood that exhibitors assume entire responsibility and hereby agree to protect, indemnify, defend, and save harmless NC & SC ACC employees and agents against all claims, losses and damages to persons or property, governmental charges and/or fines, and attorney's fees arising out of or caused by the exhibitor's installation, removal, maintenance, occupancy or use of the exhibition premises or part thereof. In addition, the exhibitor acknowledges that NC & SC ACC do not maintain insurance covering exhibitor's property and that any such insurance, if desired, is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to obtain business interruption and property damage insurance covering such losses by exhibitor.
8. NC & SC ACC reserve the right to reject a company as an exhibitor, without explanation.
9. Exhibitors are requested not to hold events or entertain attendees during any educational or social events sponsored by NC & SC ACC.
